



Competitor landscape - PMI using NHS

In a survey of PMI customers, done for this retreat, $\sim\!30\%$ said either they or their family have had NHS treatment in past 3 years

c. 1/3 of PMI customers have themselves or have family that have had NHS treatment in past 3 years
