You say at paragraph 28(c) about *Theory of harm 2: market power of individual consultants and/or consultant groups in certain local areas*:

I go further and argue that the safe practice of modern medicine requires formal collaboration. I believe the single handed practitioner is inherently unsafe due to complexity of current medical practice.
