When landing on runway 25 in a surface wind of 270°/15 knots, the aircraft bounced and drifted over the left side of the runway. The pilot applied power after the first bounce but was unable to prevent the aircraft bouncing again on the grass beside the runway before it finally came to rest. During the impact sequence the left wing struck the ground and the nosewheel collapsed.
