The aircraft was landing on Runway 05 at Sandown; the surface was dry grass and the wind was light and variable. The pilot reported that he had misjudged the flare and had stalled the aircraft which resulted in a heavy landing. He considered that the uneven surface of the runway and the poor forward vision from the cockpit were contributory factors.
