After an uneventful flight lasting 30 minutes the pilot re-joined the circuit for landing on Runway 03 which is hard surfaced. The weather was good with no significant wind. At touchdown he allowed the tailwheel to touch heavily before the maingear and the tailwheel link attachment bolt failed. The tailwheel assembly was configured for racing with a solid link rather than a spring.

As the aircraft slowed the pilot shut down the engine and switched off the fuel. At about 15 kt he lost directional control and the aircraft ground looped to the right. The left wingtip touched the ground but the aircraft remained upright and he exited normally.
