The pilot reports that after a sightseeing flight in fine weather conditions he returned to Leicester where he made a good approach and landing on runway 28. However, after touch down he was unable to maintain directional control and the aircraft turned over and came to rest inverted. Both occupants were secured by lap and diagonal restraint harness which held throughout the accident sequence and they vacated the aircraft having sustained minor injuries. The surface wind at the time is reported to have been 220°/10 knots with gusts to 15 knots.
