The surface wind was 300°/13 kt and the pilot reported some turbulence on the approach to runway 27. In the flare, at about 10 feet agl, the aircraft stalled. The main impact was taken by the nosewheel and it was immediately apparent that this had been damaged. The nose was held off for as long as possible whilst the engine was shutdown but the propeller continued to rotate and struck the runway several times. Both occupants, who were wearing full upper torso restraint, escaped without injury.
