The aircraft was on a cross-country flight from Stapleford to Newbury via Reigate when just to the west of Newbury a partial power failure occurred. A Mayday call was made on 124.75 Mhz and an emergency landing was carried out at the nearest airfield which was Greenham Common.

During the landing the aircraft bounced three or four times and the propeller struck the runway before the aircraft came to rest. The pilot and his passenger were able to evacuate the aircraft without difficulty.

The engine is awaiting a strip examination but is thought to have dropped a valve.
