The wing of G-OODO was built in France in 1980—81 to a modified Stephens Akro design; the modifications being intended to improve the wing strength. The structure consisted of a continuous solid spar from tip to tip, tapering from the root to the tip, and manufactured from laminated Douglas Fir. The ribs fore and aft of the main spar were constructed from 1.5 mm thick three-ply wood panels with circular lightening holes reinforced around the perimeter with a 7×7 mm wooden fillet bonded to the ply surface.
