The instructor was demonstrating a run-on, constant attitude, autorotative landing into a 20 gusting 25 kt headwind. As the aircraft touched down, he felt that the front of the skids were tending to dig into the soft ground and so he applied rearwards cyclic stick and full collective lever. The pilot states that a gust of wind then caused the retreating main rotor blade to strike the tail boom.
