During the end of the landing roll, the pilot's attention was distracted by the illumination of the 'Over Voltage' warning light in the cockpit. He consequently allowed the aircraft to continue rolling to a point at the end of the runway which necessitated a sharp turn in order avoid the boundary hedge.

A right turn was initiated but the left wingtip brushed the hedge and caused the aircraft to swing left into it. Having shut down the engine, the pilot left the aircraft without further incident.
