The aircraft was engaged on a commemorative flight from Marck Aeroport, Calais, to Dover Castle Meadow. During the flight the engine suffered a gradual overheating problem which resulted in a reduction in power. The pilot was eventually forced to ditch in the English Channel some  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles from Dover and was rescued uninjured by an accompanying SAR helicopter.

The aircraft was recovered from the sea and it is hoped to restore it to a flying condition.
