The aircraft was intending to land on Runway 21 of the grass strip which was approximately 550 metres long. The surface wind was 270°/10-15 kt. After a satisfactory stabilised approach the aircraft bounced on landing. Because of the proximity of other aircraft on the airstrip the pilot considered that a go-around was appropriate. There was insufficient remaining airstrip for this and, by the time the go-around was abandoned, there was insufficient room to stop the aircraft, which collided with the boundary hedge. There was no fire and the occupants, who were using full harnesses, were uninjured.
