The aircraft was landing on runway 27 at Jersey. The weather was generally fine with a wind of 290° at 25 knots. After a normal approach and landing, the nose gear leg collapsed at an estimated speed of 30–40 knots. During the subsequent inspection, it was found that the nose gear down lock plate was slightly bent, and may have prevented the nose gear locking claws from closing fully.
