A night landing was carried out during which bumpy flying conditions were experienced on finals. After touchdown the indications in the cockpit were of a flat tyre on the righthand side. On inspection the oleo was seen to be leaning back at an acute angle.

Subsequent examination showed that a bolt had sheared in the right hand main gear drag link; the failure was most probably caused by fatigue originating from a corrosion pit.
