The pilot reports that on touch down on runway 26 the aircraft swung violently to the right and despite full left rudder he was unable to stop the swing. The wind was reported as 300°/5 to 8 kt. In order to increase the airflow over the rudder he opened the throttle and as this did not correct the swing he decided to take-off again.

The aircraft was by now on the grass and heading in a north westerly direction but soon after it became airborne it struck a bush and stopped climbing. The pilot then closed the throttle and landed the aircraft straight ahead in the Blackbushe Market carpark.
