The helicopter was taking off at a high, but less than maximum weight in light and variable wind conditions from a site in a steep wooded valley. The take off involved a straight climb out for approximately 200 yards then left 40° to avoid flying over houses, but it required flying over a road and a farm building. The power limit was reached after crossing the road and the additional collective pitch required to clear the approaching farm building resulted in overpitching. While attempting to restore rotor RPM a heavy landing was made on a hillside approximately 100 yards beyond the farm building. There were no injuries.
