The aircraft was parked in the rear rank of a double row of aircraft on the west apron. After refuelling the pilot obtained clearance to taxi to a garage. He headed for a gap in the front rank left by an aircraft that had just moved away from ahead and obliquely to his left. Obscured from view by the nose of his own aircraft another aircraft lay ahead and only slightly to his left. He saw this aircraft only when its fin and rudder appeared above his engine cowling. He was unable to stop before his propeller and right interwing strut struck the tail of the parked aircraft causing substantial damage to its tail empennage.
