The aircraft landed on runway 17 and commenced taxiing back to the parking area. A yaw to the left developed and could not be contained by the application of opposite rudder. The nose wheel ran onto soft ground and sank causing the tips of the propeller to strike the ground and suffer minor damage. The weather recorded at 1520 hrs was 170°T/12 K visibility 12 Km, rain, 1 okta 1000 feet.
