After a flight from White Waltham, the pilot made an approach to Runway 08 at Compton Abbas. The wind was described as variable at 10 kt, but giving a slight tailwind component. The approach speed was too high and, as a result, the aircraft ballooned and then descended with a high sink rate. Although the pilot tried to correct this with an application of power the aircraft made a heavy landing. It then porpoised down the runway before swinging to the left and coming to rest in rough ground beside the runway.
