The aircraft made a normal approach to Runway 07. The reported wind was 050°/15 knots gusting to 25 knots. Just before touchdown the aircraft encountered a gust and landed heavily. The initial landing run was uneventful, but after about 300 metres the aircraft veered to the right. On application of corrective rudder, the aircraft veered to the left and then abruptly to the right. The pilot stopped the aircraft on the runway using moderate braking whereupon it adopted a nose-down attitude and the propeller struck the runway causing the engine to stop. The nose undercarriage strut had partially collapsed.
