The pilot was making an into-wind approach at a private landing site. The aircraft weight was close to the maximum permitted and the approach to the site was unobstructed. Although a normal approach to land was possible, the pilot elected to establish a high hover before landing. On entering the hover at 30-40 feet, the rotor rpm was towards the lower end of the permitted band, shortly after entering the hover, the rotor low rpm warning horn sounded and the aircraft yawed to the right. The pilot corrected the yaw using left pedal before he lowered the collective lever. Rotor rpm decayed to 80% and aircraft struck the ground before the pilot could take recovery action.
