The purpose of the flight was to make a series of circuits and practice landings using runway 06 at Inverness with the wind from approximately 030° (M) at 10 kt. Following an uneventful first circuit and landing a second approach was made in slightly turbulent conditions. The aircraft touched down at an indicated airspeed of 40 kt with the throttle closed. During the ground roll a swing to the left into wind developed. The pilot attempted to correct this by coarse application of right rudder which resulted in a sharp swing to the right followed by a ground loop. The aircraft travelled sideways for a short distance causing the main landing gear to collapse and it finally came to rest facing back down the runway.
