The helicopter was approaching to land on a grass area to the south of runway 26 in clear weather with a surface wind of 240°/10 kt. When the collective lever was raised at an indicated airspeed of 5 to 10 kt and a rate of descent between 500 and 600 fpm, the rate of descent increased. The aircraft landed heavily and rolled on to its side. The pilot attributed the accident to vortex ring effect.
