The purpose of the flight was to pick up a passenger at the farm. Upon arrival, the commander made a low and slow visual inspection of the proposed landing area but failed to see an electricity cable which was suspended across the field from poles not within its perimeter.

Just as the helicopter was coming to the hover, it struck the cable which then wrapped itself around the main rotor mast. Although the helicopter turned through 90°, the commander was able to make a safe landing.
