Whilst carrying out a full stop landing, the nose leg collapsed at speed of 20-30 kt; the aircraft was vacated without injury. Examination of the aircraft by the maintenance organisation has failed to reveal the cause of the accident. Final testing after repair and reinstallation of the engine is awaited.
