The pilot carried out a normal 3-point landing on runway 03 in a surface wind of 060°/18 knots. Initially the aircraft ran straight ahead but during the landing roll it swung sharply to the right. Opposite rudder was applied and it swung round to the left, at which point the pilot switched off the engine. The right undercarriage leg collapsed and the aircraft slewed round through 180°.

There was no fire and the diagonal upper torso restraints of both occupants withstood the impact. Evacuation of the aircraft was effected through the normal exit.
