Following a local flight the pilot joined the circuit from the east for Runway 03. The weather was good and there was a light northerly surface wind. With 20° of flap selected the aircraft turned onto final approach and crossed the threshold with an airspeed of 70/75 kt. The pilot closed the throttle and the aircraft floated for longer than normal without the airspeed reducing. A heavy landing followed and, after one or two bounces, the pilot went around for a further circuit. On the second approach the aircraft crossed the threshold at about 65 kt and, after landing normally, the pilot found that control was difficult because of a punctured nosewheel tyre. He was cleared to vacate the runway onto the grass where the engine was shut down.
