The aircraft was on a local flight from a private airstrip where the grass runway was orientated 27/09 and measured 850 metres by 30 metres. The weather was cloudy, main base above 2000 feet with good visibility. The surface wind was not recorded. The pilot reports that as he crossed the runway 27 threshold, what seemed like a normal landing went wrong. The aircraft sank rapidly and although power was increased, he was unable to prevent a heavy touch down. The right wing contacted the ground and the aircraft yawed out of control until it was stopped by contact with a boundary hedge on the north of the airstrip. The pilot, who had been wearing a full upper torso restraint harness, vacated the aircraft without injury.
